

MINUTES OF THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING HELD
OCTOBER 24, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. in the Vernal City Council room, 374 East Main,
Vernal, Utah 84078.

PRESENT: Councilmembers Nicholas Porter, Dave Everett, Robin O’Driscoll, Ted Munford and Corey Foley and Mayor Doug Hammond.
