

RESOLUTION 2017-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING VERNAL CITY TO SIGN ON TO TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE UTAH UNIFIED CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS Vernal City is one of the owners and sponsoring entities of the Vernal Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, a condition of receiving certain federal funding in connection with the airport is a mandate to establish and participate in a disadvantaged business enterprise program; and

WHEREAS entities in Utah have established the Utah Unified Certification Program by Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Utah Unified Certification Program has notified Uintah County and Vernal City and the Vernal Regional Airport that it is required to "sign on" to the Interlocal Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Vernal City Council as follows:

SECTION 1. Interlocal Agreement. As required by federal regulation, Vernal City as a recipient for the Vernal Regional Airport of USDOT FUNDING agrees to participate in the Utah Unified Certification Program and to sign on to the Interlocal Agreement creating the Utah Unified Certification Program.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The Mayor of Vernal City or her designee is authorized to execute a letter certifying compliance by and participation of Vernal City in the Utah Unified Certification Program.

SECTION 3. Expenses: Any costs or expenses associated with "signing on" to the Utah Unified Certification Program should be paid by the Vernal Regional Airport.

SECTION 4. Record. A copy of this Resolution along with a copy of the Interlocal Agreement establishing the Utah Unified Certification Program shall be filed in the official records of Vernal City and shall be maintained there for at least so long as Vernal City is an owner or participating agency in the Vernal Regional Airport, or for so long as otherwise required by law.

SECTION 5. Approval. The Vernal City Council hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement referred to above and authorizes the Mayor to execute it on behalf of Vernal City.

SECTION 6. Severability. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable and if any provision thereof or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this resolution or the application in a different circumstance.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
