Summary of Responsibilities:

Under the supervision of the Utility Supervisor, performs semi-skilled work in the repair and construction of utility systems of the City including water lines, sewer lines, valves and meters. Assist with routine and complex maintenance and repairs of other City utility systems such as fire hydrants, commercial water meters, manholes, etc

Example of Duties:

1. Assists in the repair of water breaks and leaks of water system lines, valves and meters.
2. Assist in the repair or maintenance of sewer lines.
3. Operates light equipment or tools in the execution of utility line repair and maintenance needs.
4. Responds to emergency utility calls, assesses repair needs and notifies necessary personnel of the situation.
5. Assists in the installation of water lines, valves and meters.
6. Follow sanitation procedures and other health standards as necessary to maintain the Vernal City utility systems.
7. Assist with reading and recording water consumption in the culinary water system which may include removal of ice, snow, dirt or mud from the meters.
8. Assist in the Investigation of abnormalities in water consumption and water losses.
9. Perform utility turn-ons and shut-offs, and leak detection checks.
10. Assist with the input of data into the computer system to record utility maintenance logs.
11. Performs other related maintenance duties as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. High School graduate or equivalent.
2. Six months (6) year successful, responsible, full-time experience in general maintenance and/or construction of public works or general utility construction or maintenance. The City may consider an equivalent combination of education and experience that would provide the required knowledge, skills and ability.
